



# ABERGELE COMMUNITY ACTION

In 2001 Abergele Youth Action was established and later became **Abergele Community Action**. In 2024 our key vision remains the same: to empower individuals and strengthen the community through innovative and impactful projects.



In **2013**, **Abergele District Foodbank** was established with the Trussell Trust to help people struggling to put food on the table. Since then, we have distributed thousands of food parcels, totalling 205.6 tonnes of food. We identify the reasons for their situations and help people find solutions by directing them to other agencies that can resolve the underlying issues.

## MONEY ADVICE

In 2018, we established **Abergele Community Money Advice** to provide free, confidential, unconditional money advice and support to everyone from all walks of life. Since then, we have handled nearly £6 million of debt, helping 482 people overcome their financial problems and start fresh on stable financial footing.

## ABERGELE COMMUNITY SHOP

Earlier this year we opened a social supermarket **Abergele Community Shop** aimed at helping people who are struggling with the increased cost of living or with a lower level of disposable income, the Community Shop, which is based on Platform 1 (beach side) of Pensarn Station, is a social supermarket with a difference. The Community Shop redistributes food, consisting of high quality products that would otherwise go to waste.

Food donated to the Foodbank is used to provide emergency food parcels only and is not available in the shop.



Abergele Youth Shed continues to go from strength to strength providing a safe place for young people to explore new skills and experiences.
