Councillor Griffiths updated that Councillor John Roberts was currently an in-patient at Glan Clwyd Hospital. Councillor Ifor Lloyd offered his sympathy to the Clerk Mel Jones following the death of his father-in-law- John Lloyd Jones. This was echoed by the meeting and they were thanked for their kind words by Mr Mel Jones

11. INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL AUDIT MATTERS.

The Annual Audit for the year ending 31st March 2024 will be a 'Full Audit' and will require submission before the end of September 2024.

12. CONWY COUNTY COUNCIL MATTERS - COUNCILLOR IFOR LLOYD

County Councillor Ifor LLOYD updated that together with the Clerk and the Clerk of Llanfair TH Community Council they had met Open Reach regarding the new Government Funding to bring Full fibre Deployment to Premises in the Dolwen telephone exchange area. It was explored if the area covered can be extended but that is not a possibility at this stage. The presentation was helpful and householders should be encouraged to register. Open Reach are looking to hold information meetings locally.

13. MAINTENANCE OF RESOURCES WITHIN THE COMMUNITY COUNCIL AREA.

a. Playground at Betws yn Rhos/Llanelian

The Clerk is planning to explore various avenues with Community, Engagement and Participation Officer - Conwy and Denbighshire Local Authority so as to collect the necessary information and quotes to apply for grants from sources such as Gwynt y Mor to refurbish the Betws yn Rhos and Llanelian yn Rhos Children's Playing Fields.

On Thursday 6th June 2024 the Clerk met a representative of Creative Play, Seland at the Betws yn Rhos playground for them to look at improvements and provide an estimate for refurbishing/replacements/additions. The estimate and artwork have been received. The estimated cost of installing a dart activity centre and a basket swing with grass mats and associated works is £17,150.00 Ther was an agreement that the current playground equipment should be retained and refurbished as per the plan by Creative Play. The estimate for refurbishing from G.L. Jones is historic and a new estimate will need to be obtained. The Clerk will liaise with Conwy County Council to discuss financial support. There will be a requirement for grants to be applied for and the Clerk will liaise with CVSC.

b. Defibrillators

With regard to the siting of a defibrillator in the Dawn area. On the 19th June 2024 Councillor John Roberts and the Clerk had met with Ifan Rowlands (Street Lighting Manager CCBC) on site near the new bridge in Dawn. Mr Rowlands confirmed that electricity could be easily sourced from a nearby electric pole and CCBC would install a post to locate the defibrillator onto. Mr Rowlands would arrange to send an estimate for the work and also to obtain an estimate from Scottish Power for the electrical work.

The Clerk reported that the estimates have not been received to date and that he would chase this up. There would be a need to purchase a new defibrillator when the work is completed. The Clerk reported that to date despite several requests the Defibrillators had not been transferred to the new account.

c. The Hub'/ 'Yr Hwb'.

Volunteers are still required to supervise the meetings which will run between 9:00 and 12:00pm every Tuesday morning at the Sports Pavilion, Betws yn Rhos.

d. Flower beds

Councillor Gethin OWEN will proceed with placing them on the B5381 near the Betws yn Rhos village sign as travelling from Penrefail Crossroads and at Rhwng y Ddwyffordd the County Council nursery at Tan Lan would supply plants.

There is also concerns regarding the lack of flowers in the pots around the village and the area around the benches on Abergele Road being overgrown with weeds etc.

The Clerk had made contact with ERF at CCBC and also Parks and Gardens to establish if they will attend to the issues. There has been no response to date. It was decided that attempts would be made to source a Gardener/Handyman to carry out the weeding and grass cutting around the benches and maintain the flower pots,

e. Toilet Facility at Betws yn Rhos

The Clerk had E mailed Conwy Council Estates regarding the plans for the toilet block at Betws yn Rhos. A reply has been received from Ceri Owen (Public Conveniences) who updated that the toilet block – a concrete structure - had been closed since 2008. The drains have collapsed and the Council had assessed that the toilet block was unfeasible to be renovated.

As the toilet block is beyond economical repair the siting of a toilet adjacent to the Sports Pavilion will need to be progressed. The Sports Association will need to obtain the relevant planning permission. The Community Council will provide necessary assistance.

f. General issues

The Clerk had written to ERF at Conwy Council regarding the barrier at the end of the public footpath and also the decking on the river bank at Llais Afon flats. They had acknowledged receipt under reference 112632. The work is classed as non-urgent

14. ANNUAL BUDGET / PRECEPT

The precept application had been agreed by CCBC at £13,000.00. \pounds 4,334.00 will be paid into the account on 19/4/24,16/8/24 and 13/12/24

15. ON and OFF-SHORE WIND FARMS AWEL Y MOR/GWYNT Y MOR/MONA

This subject remains on the agenda, and any developments discussed at every meeting. Any further plans or applications will be monitored closely.

16. LLANELIAN YN RHOS COMMUNITY CENTRE.

This item remains on the Agenda so that we can keep up with how the project is progressing, and so that we can offer support when required.

The new building is now progressing well. All future Council meetings will be held at the Sports Pavilion at Betws yn Rhos until the Llanelian re-build has been completed.

The work by BT to install WiFi is ongoing and a new line need installing at the building. It is frustrating that BT are taking weeks to carry out the promised work.

The Clerk has arranged for CCTV Services to provide an estimate for installing the same equipment as at the Sports Pavilion in Betws yn Rhos

17. Y GADLAS

No suggestion as to an article.

18. ANY OTHER MATTERS

Councillor Irwedd Griffiths raised an issue with a narrow bend between Nant y Cochl and Bryn Derwen which had caused difficulty for large vehicles delivering in the area and damage had been caused to both vehicles and the verge. The Clerk agreed to report the matter to ERF.
